	CURIOUS GROWTH FORM	Any tree or group of trees that is/are of outstanding interest because it exhibits a curious growth form or physical feature arising from abnormal outgrowths, natural fusion of branches, natural damage or pruning.	
	HISTORIC VALUE	Any tree or groups of trees important to the cultural or natural history of the area through the commemoration of a particular occasion including plantings by notable people or having association with an important event in history.	
	OUTSTANDING EXAMPLE OF A SPECIES	Any tree or group of trees that is/are an outstanding example of its/their species, including good form, structure and health.
