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Before you lodge your application for a tree permit ensure that you have checked the following:			
	That you have read Council's Fact Sheet 25 and understand the criteria in the document.		
	Applications for the <u>removal</u> of a tree need to be accompanied by an Arborist's report outlining why it is necessary to remove the tree, unless there are very visually obvious roots causing the damage.		
	If there are structural issues with buildings and there is not very obvious damage, applications need to be accompanied by a structural engineer's report.		
	Where sewer damage is occurring, the application needs to be accompanied by a plumber's report stating damage, location of damage and whether it will be ongoing and what is causing the damage.		
	Please put on the form the time that you will be available onsite if you wish to be there. Council's officer will attend the site as close to the nominated time as possible. If more than one applicant nominates the same time the Council officer will ring to offer another time.		
	If there is no time nominated on the form the officer will attend at some time on the Wednesday.		
	If you have a current Development Application you need to refer to your development consent conditions before lodging an application.		
NOTE: All permits will be posted to you after processing your application.
