SMALL TREE LIST

This is a list of small trees that may be suitable for planting in your area. This list is not comprehensive and you should seek information on these and other suitable trees. Look for information on the Internet, library, gardening books and magazines and by talking to horticulturalists/gardeners. Look at what is growing well in your neighbourhood. Plants benefit from soil improvement prior to planting.

Plants require extra care (regular deep watering and mulching) to get them established. Trees should be located so they have enough space (width and height) and do not conflict with services (power, water etc) or your neighbours.

*Acacia sp.	Wattles	Up to	Yellow/Cream flowers.
Acer buergeranum	Trident maple	10m 8m	Native. Bright red leaves in autumn, deciduous
Acmena smithii (cultivars)	Lilly Pilly	10m	Bushy with berries. Native.
Agonis flexuosa	Western Australian Willow Myrtle	8m	Drooping foliage, Cream/white flowers. Native.
Albizia julibrissin	Silk Tree	8m	Deciduous, Pink flowers
Amelanchier laevis 'cumulus'	Serviceberry / shad bush	8m	Deciduous, small white flowers, Bronze leaves.
Angophora bakeri	Narrow leafed apple	8m	Rough bark. Cream/white flowers. Native.
Archontophoenix alexandrae/cunninghamiana	Alexander/Bangalow Palm	15m x 3m	Self-cleaning Palm. Good cocos palm substitute. 2 palms =1replacement tree
Backhousia citriodora	Lemon myrtle	8m	White flowers. Avoid frost. Native.
Backhousia myrtifolia	Grey myrtle	6m	White flowers. Native.
Banksia integrifolia	Coast Banksia	10m	Lime flowers. Attracts birds.
Banksia serrata	Old man Banksia	10m	Green flowers. Gnarled trunk, Attracts birds.
Brachychiton populneus	Kurrajong	10m	Small attractive tree. Symmetrical shape. Native.
Buckinghamia celsissima	Ivory curl flower	10m	Lots of Cream flowers. Native.
Callicoma serratifolia	Black wattle	8m	Cream flowers, small tree

Callistemon viminalis	Weeping bottlebrush	8m	Red flowers. Native.
Callitris rhomboidea	Port Jackson pine	8m	Native conifer
* Ceratopetalum gummiferum	NSW Christmas Bush	* 7m	Flowers turn pink/red in December. Native.
* Cercis siliquastrum	Judas tree	* 7m	Deciduous, purple flowers.
Cupressus sempervirens	Italian Cypress	15m	Narrow feature tree, Dark green.
Cupressus torulosa	Bhutan cypress	12m	Pendulous branching conifer
Elaeocarpus reticulatus	Blueberry Ash	8m	Attractive leaves, flowers and small blue edible fruit. Native.
Fraxinus griffithi	Evergreen ash	12m	Requires deep soil &root space.
Hymenosporum flavum	Native Frangipani	8m	Slender native tree with frangipani-like flowers.
Koelreuteria paniculata	Golden Rain Tree	8m	Deciduous, Yellow flowers
Melaleuca decora	Honey Myrtle	10m	White flowers in summer. Native.
Melaleuca linarifolia	Snow in Summer	8m	White flowers in summer. Native.
Parrotia persica	Persian Witch Hazel	8m	Deciduous, Brilliant multi- coloured leaves.
*Photinia robusta	Chinese Hawthorn	* 7m	White flowers. New leaves bronze. large shrub.
Pistacia chinensis	Chinese pistachio	8m	Attractive autumn colour, deciduous
*Pittosporum eugenioides	Tarata	* 7m	Variegated leaves. Bushy, good screen.
Pyrus calleryana	Callery Pear	8m	Deciduous, leaves yellow & red In autumn.
Pyrus ussuriensis	Manchurian Pear	9m	Deciduous, leaves bronze In autumn.
Sapium sebiferum	Chinese tallowtree	10m	Attractive autumn foliage.
Tristaniopsis laurina	Water Gum	10m	Popular small tree. Commonly used in streets. Native.

These are just a few suggestions. Your local Nursery, Garden Centre, Arborist or Horticulturalist can assist you in selecting the best tree for your property.
